Bond granted teen in 2019 Augusta shooting case

An Augusta teen accused of wounding two young men in a shooting outside his home was granted bond Tuesday.

Emanuel Ivey, 17, was still in high school when he allegedly fired at a vehicle on the street in front of his house Nov. 25, 2019. Two of the three men inside the vehicle were wounded. Bullets also pierced the walls of the home of a neighbor who was inside with his two children cowering in fear, said Assistant District Attorney Randi Brandon.

Tuesday in Richmond County Superior Court, defense attorney Keith Johnson brought the judge recordings of social media postings, purportedly made by one of the victims, in which the victim allegedly threatened to kill Ivey.

Ivey, who was 16 years old when arrested, was in fear for his life when he saw the male who threatened him in front of his home, in a neighborhood where the driver had no reason to visit, Johnson said. Ivey contended one of the occupants flashed a gun at him first and there was a weapon found in the vehicle.

Ivey has no criminal history. He had been a good student who participated in school sports before his arrest, Johnson said.

Judge J. Wade Padgett cited the lack of criminal history, the length of time since Ivey's arrest and the expected time that will pass before Ivey could stand trial, as well as Ivey's family support, the location of the shooting and the ability to impose monitoring as reasons for granting bond.

Padgett set a \$10,000 bond. Regular reporting to probation services, testing for any drug or alcohol use, a 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. curfew, and attending school or work full time are conditions of bond.

Ivey has pleaded not guilty to six counts of aggravated assault, six counts of possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime and one count of criminal damage to property.
